## **ITINERARY**

- Day 01 Guests are greeted at Heydar Aliyev International Airport and transferred to their hotel for check-in. They enjoy a welcome lunch or dinner featuring traditional Azerbaijani pilaf at the charming Shirvanshakh Restaurant.
- Day 02 After breakfast, guests visit Highland Park and the historic Old City, including the Maiden Tower and Palace of the Shirvanshahs, followed by lunch at Dolma Restaurant. The afternoon includes a tour of the architecturally stunning Heydar Aliyev Center, ending with a dinner of flavorful lamb kebab at Shah Garden.
- Day 03 Guests explore the natural wonder Yanardag "Burning Mountain" and the ancient Fire Worshippers' Temple, Ateshgah, showcasing Azerbaijan's fiery heritage. The day concludes with a hands-on culinary master class where men learn to make kebabs and women prepare kutabs, followed by a delicious lunch.
